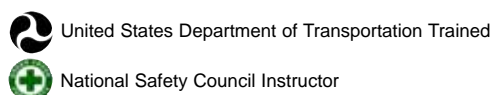

If you are in a business such as landscaping and operate a commercial motor vehicle with a gross vehicle rating (GVWR) or gross combination weight rating (GCWR) of 10,001 or more pounds, you must comply with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.
